Patriot Week focuses on our **First Principles, Founding Fathers and other Patriots, founding documents and speeches, and flags.**

by Michigan State Senate
and State House Resolutions, scores
of K-12 schools (public, charter, private,
and home), universities, law schools, student
groups, community organizations (Rotaries,
Kiwanis, senior centers, religious, and others), cities,
counties, courts, law firms, businesses, senior living
communities, libraries, hospitals, historical groups,
private homes, public officials, and others engage in
a wide range of grassroots activities (including
panel discussions, speakers, lesson plans,
picnics, commemorations, etc.). Activities
occur in MI, NY, OH, CO, AZ, GA, PA,
WA DC, IL, with more to
come!**

Anchored by the key dates of September 11 (the anniversary of the terrorists attacks) **and September 17** (Constitution Day, the anniversary of when the Constitution was signed), each day has a separate focus.

THE SCHEDULE

9/11: First Principle of **Revolution**; Thomas **Paine**, Patrick **Henry**, and John **Adams**; the **Declaration of Independence**; and the **Bennington ('76) Flag**

9/12: First Principle of the **Rule of Law**; Chief Justice John **Marshall**; **Marbury v Madison**; and the **Betsy Ross Flag**

9/13: First Principle of the **Social Compact**; George **Washington**; the Congressional Resolution forwarding the Constitution to the states for ratification; and the current **USA Flag**



9/14: First Principle of **Equality (gender)**; Elizabeth Cady **Stanton** and Susan B. **Anthony**; **Seneca Falls Declaration of Sentiments and Resolutions** and **19th Amendment**; and the **Suffragist Flag**

9/15: First Principle of **Equality (racial)**; Abraham **Lincoln**, Frederick **Douglass**, and Martin Luther **King Jr.**; **Gettysburg Address**, **Emancipation Proclamation** and **I Have a Dream** speech; and the **Union (Fort Sumter) Flag**

9/16: First Principle of **Unalienable Rights**; Thomas **Jefferson**; the **Bill of Rights**; and the **Gadsden Flag (Don't Tread on Me)**

9/17: First Principle of **Limited Government**; James **Madison**; unamended **Constitution**, **9th** and **10th** **Amendments**; and **State, County, or Municipal Flags**
