Driving Directions (We do not recommend renting a car; the directions are just for reference)

O'Hare - Take I-190 E out of the airport then merge onto I-94 E and take exit 50B toward Ohio St E, merge onto W Ohio St. Turn left onto N Dearborn St, turn left onto W Huron St. The Godfrey Hotel will be on your left.

Midway - Take I-55 N/Stevenson Expy, exit onto I-90/I-94 W and take exit 50B toward Ohio St E, merge onto W Ohio St. Turn left onto N Dearborn St, turn left onto W Huron St. The Godfrey Hotel will be on your left.

Parking

Valet Parking costs \$55/night per vehicle and offers unlimited in/out privileges. To valet your vehicle during your stay please arrive at our front entrance located and our valet staff will assist you.

Prepaid Discounted Parking Option

The website ParkWhiz, www.parkwhiz.com, allows you to enter your destination address, compare price/location, make a reservation and receive an electronic parking pass to print or use on your smartphone. Your parking space is guaranteed and you will also receive directions to your parking location. You may be able to find reduced parking rates, subject to availability, by using ParkWhiz for daily and/or overnight parking in downtown Chicago.

DIRECTIONS - O'HARE BLUE LINE "L" INFORMATION

The normal travel time on the Blue Line from O'Hare to downtown, is 40-45 minutes.

Blue Line trains run 24 hours a day, seven days a week; and all trains leaving the O'Hare station go through downtown.

Getting to the Blue Line from Terminals 1, 2 or 3

If you're coming from domestic and international flights arriving at Terminals 1, 2 or 3, follow signs in the airport to "CTA Trains" or "Trains to City." These will lead you to the train station. You can walk from the baggage claim to the train in under ten minutes from any of these three terminals.

Getting to the Blue Line from Terminal 5

If you're coming from international flights that land in Terminal 5, follow signs to the Airport Transit System (ATS). Ride the next train to Terminal 2 and exit the train at the station. Then, follow signs to "CTA Trains" or "Trains to City."

Purchase a Fare Ticket (Ventra Ticket) at the CTA Ventra Vending Machine:

Single-ride Ticket: \$3 pp

Includes a full fare and two transfers (a \$2.50 value), plus a \$0.50 limited-use media fee.

1-Day Pass Ticket: \$10 pp

Good for unlimited rides for 24 hours.

Two Options:

1) Ride the Blue Line "L" train towards Forest Park to the Clark / Lake stop. Walk up the stairs to ground level and take a short \$5-\$7 cab ride to the hotel.

2) Ride the Blue Line "L" train towards Forest Park to the Washington stop for a Red Line transfer. Follow the signs to the Red Line train through the mall, your ticket will allow a transfer so use it again and ride the Red Line towards Howard, go 2 stops to Chicago. Exit to ground level, it is a short walk 2 blocks to Chicago & LaSalle St. Turn left and walk 2 blocks to LaSalle and Huron you will see The Godfrey Hotel Chicago.

DIRECTIONS - MIDWAY ORANGE LINE "L" INFORMATION

The normal travel time on the Orange Line from Midway to downtown, is 20-30 minutes.

Orange Line trains run seven days a week during the day except during overnight hours (roughly 1 am to 4am) or after 11 pm on Sundays.

Getting to the Orange Line from the Airport

Orange Line Midway station is right next to the airport terminal building, and connected by an enclosed walkway accessible near the baggage claim area. Follow the signs to “CTA Trains” or “Trains to City” from the airport. An orange line painted on the ground will guide you there.

Purchase a Fare Ticket (Ventra Ticket) at the CTA Ventra Vending Machine:

Single-ride Ticket: \$3 pp

Includes a full fare and two transfers (a \$2.50 value), plus a \$0.50 limited-use media fee.

1-Day Pass Ticket: \$10 pp

Good for unlimited rides for 24 hours.

Two Options:

1) Ride the Orange Line "L" train towards downtown to the Clark / Lake stop. Walk down the stairs to ground level and take a short \$5-\$7 cab ride to the hotel.

2) Ride the Orange Line "L" train towards downtown to the State / Lake stop for a Red Line transfer. Follow the signs to the Red Line train, your ticket will allow a transfer so use it again and ride the Red Line towards Howard, go 2 stops to Chicago. Exit to ground level, it is a short walk 2 blocks to Chicago & LaSalle St. Turn left and walk 2 blocks to LaSalle and Huron you will see The Godfrey Hotel Chicago.

Airport Express (Share-a-Ride) Shuttle Service

For shared-ride shuttle services to or from O'Hare or Midway, call 1-888-284-3826 or visit www.airportexpress.com. The rate for O'Hare is approximately \$27 one-way; \$49 round-trip. The rate for Midway is approximately \$22 one-way; \$39 round-trip. Parties of two or more reserving at the same time receive a discount. Please visit the website for more information.
